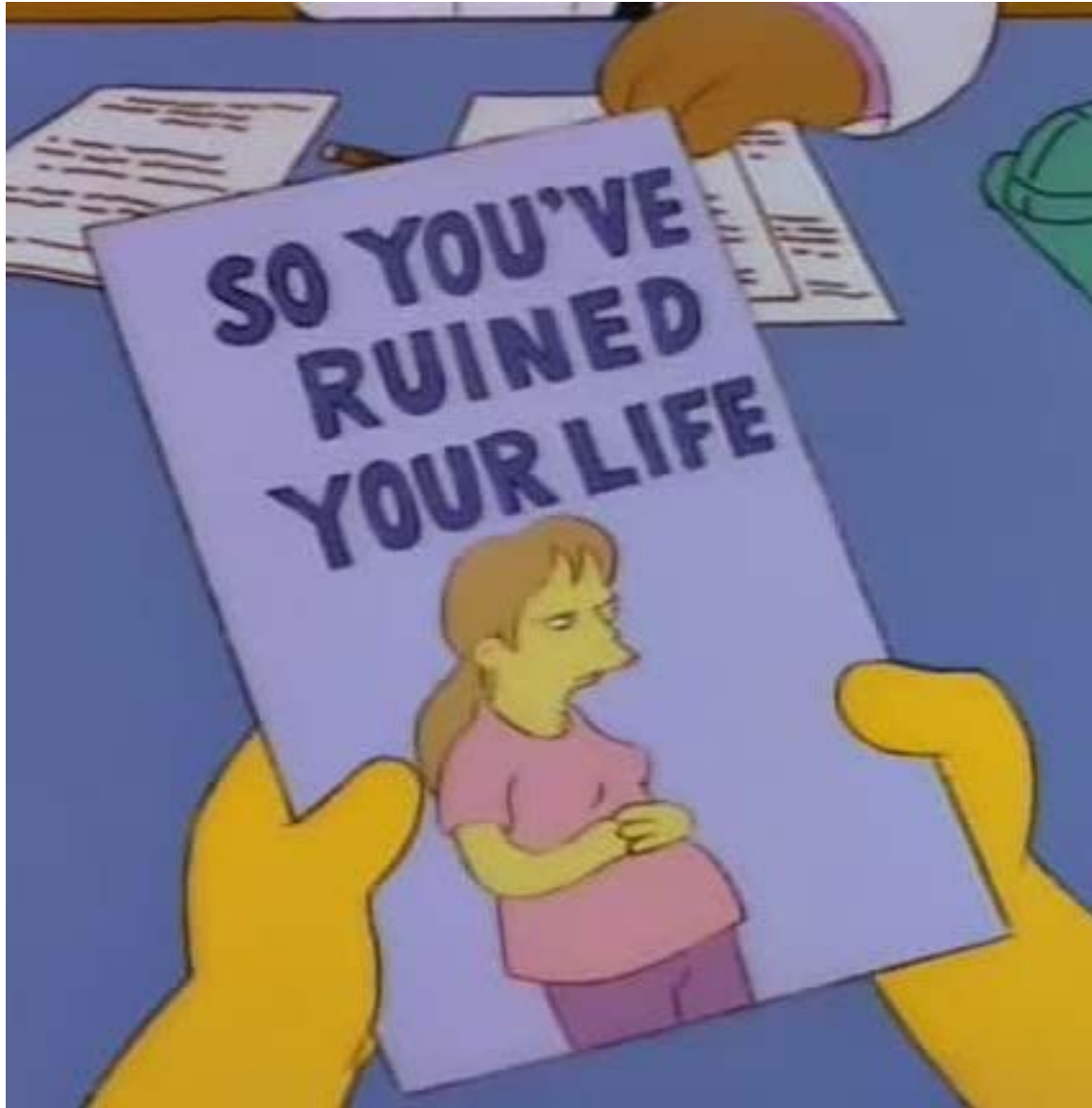

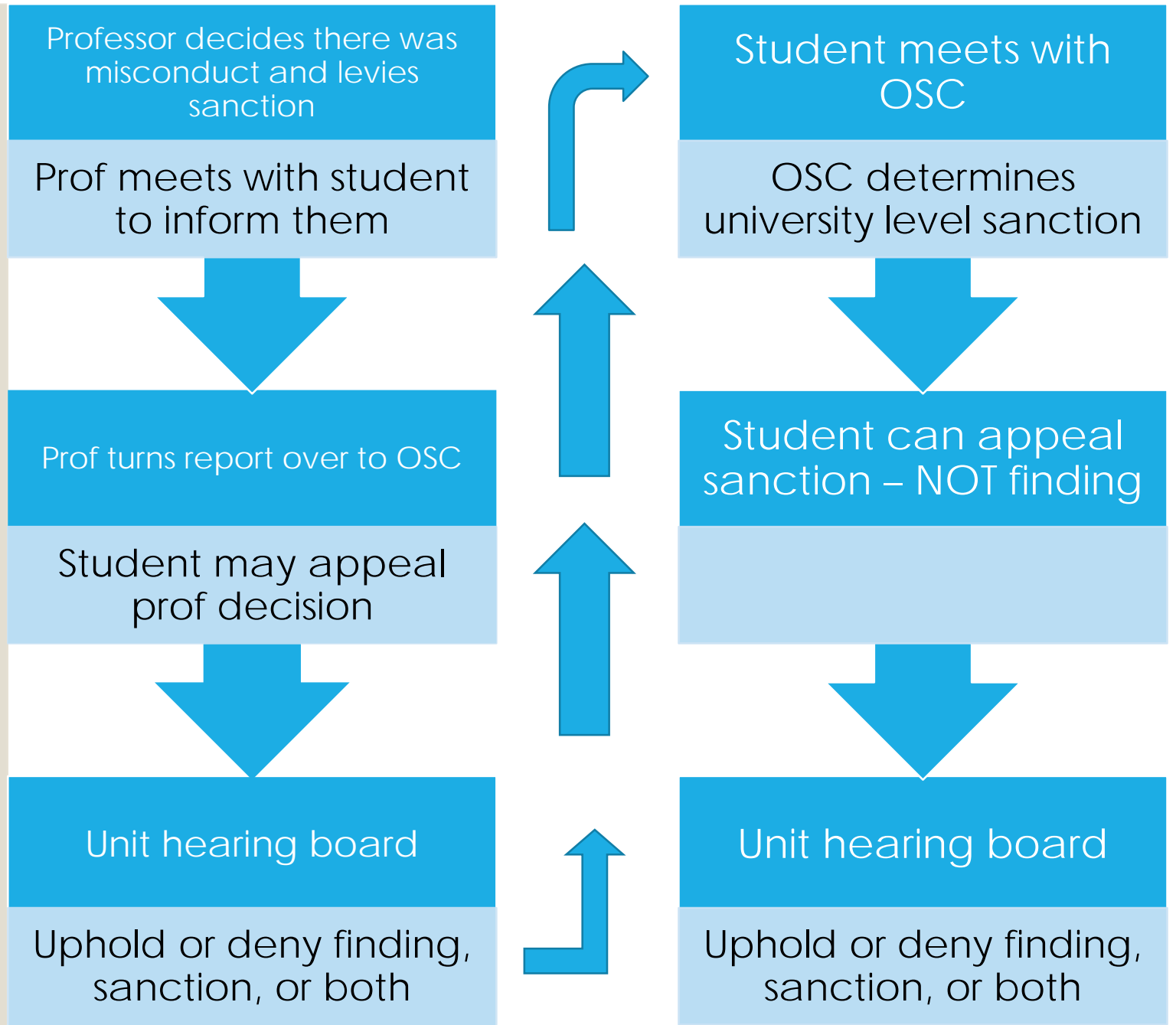

Personal Misconduct

- Drug use/possession
- Bar fights
- Fake IDs
- Resisting arrest
- Public intoxication
- DUI
- Covid violations



PERSONAL MISCONDUCT

Intersection between criminal justice system and IU personal misconduct

Any accusation related to sex – sexual harassment, sexual exploitation, sexual assault

Any accusation related to domestic violence – battery, stalking, etc

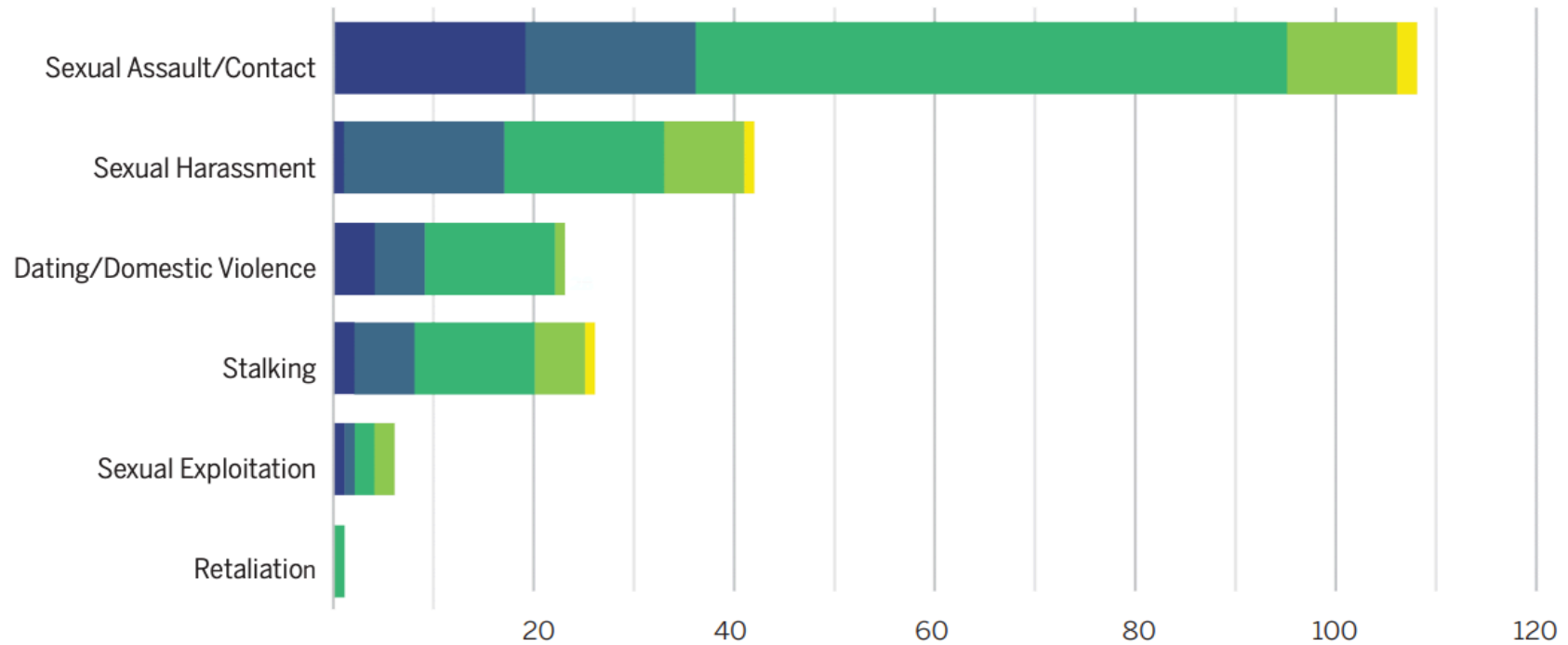
Title IX

“ No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”

The 28 reports that went through the Formal University Resolution Process resulted in 27 outcomes as two reports were related to the same respondent.

How are IU cases different than “real” court?

- Terminology
 - Judicial conference
 - Hearing commission
 - Respondent/complainant
 - Responsible/not responsible
 - “Separation” from IU
 - Alternative resolution
- Communication with the school
 - FERPA
 - Ghostwriting
- Preponderance standard
- Different approach
 - What they want to hear
 - Unlike in court, remember you have little to no leverage and little to no ability to negotiate

- One of these
 - Reprimand and warning
 - Disciplinary probation
 - *Deferred suspension* (rare)
 - Suspension
 - Expulsion
- Any of the following are options:
 - Expulsion from residence hall
 - Counseling/treatment
 - “Educational” component
 - Reflection paper
 - Meeting with someone else at IU
 - Community service

Possible
outcomes

Interim/summary suspension



One-way ticket to suspension



- Violence causing injury
- Threat of violence
- Drug dealing or possession of large amount of drugs
- Sexual assault
- Repeated incidents
- Maxing out on disciplinary probation
